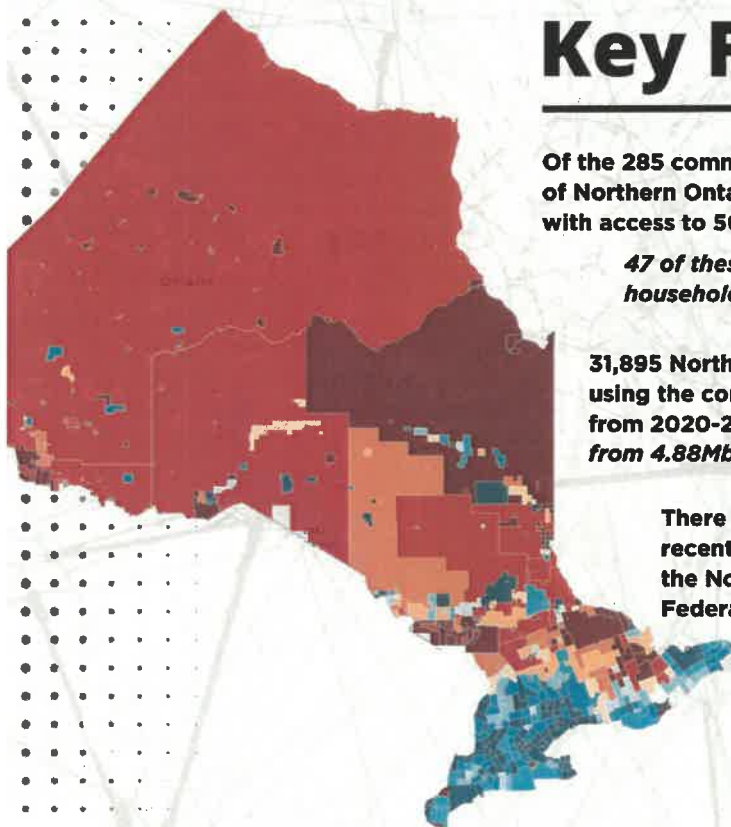

Key Findings:

Of the 285 communities within the Federally defined region of Northern Ontario, 74 have at least 50% of households with access to 50/10Mbps broadband speeds.

47 of these communities have at least 75% of households able to access 50/10Mbps.

31,895 Northern Ontario speed tests were recorded using the connectednorth.ca CIRA-powered speed test from 2020-2022: *The median download speed increased from 4.88Mbps to 20.21Mbps.*

There are presently 73 announced, in-progress or recently completed broadband projects throughout the Northern Ontario region receiving either Federal or Provincial support.
