



NOTICE OF FILMING

To the Residents and Businesses around Eagle Lake, Machar Township, August 8th, 2021

You may have heard the buzz around town regarding “The Lake” filming in and around North Bay and South River this summer. The same group of people that were in North Bay a few years back making “Carter” loved it so much they have returned and this time with a comedy.

The Lake is a half-hour comedy about the Canadian Cottage Experience centered on an unconventional father/daughter relationship. Justin, a recently divorced man, brings Billie, the biracial daughter he gave up for adoption, to the lake where he summered as a boy.

Two of our main locations in Machar Township are Hockey Opportunity Camp and Eagle Lake Narrows Country Store.

To accommodate all our trucks, we are using the field across the road from the HOC while filming at the HOC, and the Eagle Lake Marina while filming at the Eagle Lake Narrows Country Store. From here we can stage everything all in one area, tech trucks, lunch tents and cast and crew cars. We will be sure to leave the road open for emergency vehicles at all times.

All filming at the HOC will be on private property starting **August 18th, 19th, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th** and should in no way impede anyone’s enjoyment on the lake this summer. Hours of filming will vary from 7:00 am to 2:00 am depending on the day. While filming at the **Eagle Lake Narrows Country Store on Monday, August 23rd (between 7am & 9pm)** we will have 2 OPP officers with their squad cars with us all day to help us with intermediate traffic control while filming. We will also be closing the parking area across from the store the night before with Road Cones and will have security staff on hand to keep it clear for filming. The public beach is open to the public but the area closest to the road we would ask to leave clear while filming.

The Lake is working with the Township of Machar to obtain all necessary film permits. We will do our absolute best so not to disrupt the neighborhood.
